2.12.010 City planning commission created.

The North Sioux City planning commission is created for the city. (Ord. 394 § 1, 2002)

2.12.020 Membership of the planning commission.

The city planning commission shall consist of five members and two alternate members

appointed by the mayor, subject to the approval of the common council. The members and alternate members of this planning commission shall be resident electors of the city, qualified by knowledge or experience to act in matters pertaining to the development and administration of a city planning commission. The alternate members shall, in the absence of the regular members, fulfill their duties and act in matters pertaining to the development and administration of the city planning commission. (Ord. 394 § 2, 2002)

2.12.030 Terms of members.

The term of each member of the planning commission shall be for five years. Appointment of each member shall be for terms of five years so that there will be an overlapping of tenures. (Ord. 394 § 3, 2002)

2.12.040 Vacancies.

Any vacancy in a membership on the planning commission shall be filled for the unexpired term in the same manner as for appointment. (Ord. 394 § 4, 2002)

2.12.050 Removal for cause.

The mayor with the confirmation of the common council, after public hearing, shall have authority to remove any member of the planning commission for cause that shall be stated in writing and made a part of the record of such hearing. (Ord. 394 § 5, 2002)

2.12.060 Compensation and expenses.

All members of the planning commission shall receive compensation in the amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each scheduled and adjourned meeting attended. Compensation for other actual expenses, shall be subject to the approval of common council. (Ord. 394 § 6, 2002)
